the gilded-bronze mount with thistle-and-rose frieze, suspended on three chains
from top palmate boss, with similar centre and fruiting bud finial; the dish with
circles of diamond cutting interspersed with fan design.
Circa 1830, restored and adapted for inner splay of lights.
